### UTILITY RATE INCREASE – Effective January 1, 2010

Water Rates – No change  
 Sewer Rates – will change from \$10.00 per month flat rate to the following:

- \$12.00 per month minimum charge plus
- \$2.00 per 1,000 gallons of water used over the minimum of 2,500 gallons.

\* This will provide for a rate that reflects the impact on the sewage system which is directly related to the amount of water used.
