UTILITY RATE INCREASE – EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2010

Water Rates – No change

Sewer Rates – will change from \$10.00 per month flat rate to the following:

\$12.00 per month minimum charge plus

\$2.00 per 1,000 gallons of water used over the minimum of 2,500 gallons.

* This will provide for a rate that reflects the impact on the sewage system which is directly related to the amount of water used.

TOWN POLICY AND BYLAW INFORMATION:

Snow Removal Policy – Bylaw 1/2007

- Residents must remove and clear away all snow and ice from the sidewalks adjoining the property owned or occupied by them within 24 hours of accumulation.
- If not completed the town may authorize said removal and clearing away to be done by any other person at the expense of said owner and/or occupier of said premises. All expenses incurred by the municipality, in this regards will be invoiced to the owner and/or occupant and if not paid within 30 days shall be applied to the property taxes of the property that was affected.
- Please do not clear your snow on to the sidewalk, street or lane. The only exception to this is the downtown commercial area.
- Any snow placed on the sidewalk, street or lane will be removed by the Town of Kamsack and all costs will be invoiced to the owner and/or occupant and if not paid within 30 days shall be applied to the property taxes of the property that the snow was originally cleared and/or removed from.
